A Change of Plans

We had planned to pick up our new engine on 17 September but on 12 September all that changed. That evening Rosanna had a stroke and was life flighted to Kansas City for emergency treatment.



She received treatment very quickly and we are optimistic that she will make a full recovery.

After she was stabilized she was moved to Emporia, KS where she is undergoing recovery therapy and is responding remarkably well.



To date she has progressed from wheel chair to walker to quad cane to single point cane and is now moving slowly and carefully around the house with no cane.

Please pray for her continued recovery.

Spare Engine Arrives!



Thank you all for your generous support.

A total of \$9460 was raised in just three weeks and we now have the spare engine in our shop at Garnett.

The engine will now be thoroughly inspected to make it ready for installation as soon as it is needed.

For safety sake, aircraft engines must be torn down and overhauled every 2000 running hours. Our right engine presently has less than 200 hours left. At the present rate we may be able to get another two years before all our time is used up but we are looking at several new areas of operation and could be needing to overhaul the engine a lot sooner. With new mission work coming up we also need to train several new pilots and that training time will use even more of our remaining engine hours.

If we had not acquired this engine, we would have had to

send the time expired engine back to the factory for overhaul. Sending the engine back to the factory would have put us out of business for at least 6 to 8 weeks (if we are lucky) and would have cost \$35,000 or more. So your generosity has saved us a significant amount of both time and money.

Our particular engine was built only one year and has a unique turbo charging system. Finding parts for that system has been very challenging and time consuming but we now have a set of the most difficult to find parts on hand.

Thank you again for making this happen!
